- RESERVE PRICES** – All reserve prices should be made in writing by **5.00pm** on the day prior to the sale, otherwise no responsibility can be accepted for errors.
- LIABILITY** – The Auctioneers do not accept responsibility for any accident, loss or damage from any cause whatsoever which may occur on the auction premises.
