**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PURCHASERS**

These notes are to be read in conjunction with the Conditions of Sale.

**If you cannot comply with the payment terms below, please do NOT bid at this auction.**

**PAYMENT:** All lots must be paid for on the day of sale.

Our terms are STRICTLY CASH, DIRECT DEBIT CARDS, CREDIT CARDS with the premium of 2% charge plus VAT. Cheques will only be accepted from known customers, unless supported by an approved letter of reference from purchasers' bank.

No clearance of goods will be allowed until payment has been made in full.
