HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLES

- 34 Additional info - LONDON TROLLEY measurements, overall length of the trolley not incl shafts: 287cms, length of the bed 210cms. Width, 175cms/height 96cms. Total height with seat 172cms, wheel diameter 74cms, shaft length 207cms, width of shafts at the narrowest point 60cms and at the widest 78cms
- 47 EXERCISE CART - **WITHDRAWN**
- 48 LONDON TROLLEY painted navy blue on a yellow undercarriage with pneumatic tyres. Decorated scrolls and grapes in red and yellow with chrome furniture and fitted with side boards sign written 'General Dealer, C Mills', with a drop-down tail board. A show condition vehicle restored and painted by Bob Walker
- 49 MEADOWBROOK-TYPE CART to fit 14 to 15.2 hh; a nice looking oak-stained vehicle with two upholstered seats, one of which folds down. On Warner wheels, metal rein rail, elliptic springs and shafts
- 50 RALLI CAR to suit 14 to 15 hh; painted navy with light blue lining. On 56ins Warner wheels with engraved brass hub caps and Dennet springs. Adjustable back to back seating in black synthetic upholstery, drop-down tail board and driver's wedge seat. Fitted with a brass rein rail and lamp brackets, leather-covered whip holder, adjustable foot plate, double metal steps and mud guards.
- 51 INVALID CARRIAGE built by John Ward, Invalid Chair Manufacturer of Leicester Square, London in the late 1800's to suit a small pony; painted black on a maroon undercarriage with black buttoned upholstery, folding hood, covered mudguards and dashboard, and metal rein rail. On iron-shod wheels with 'C' and elliptic springs. Comes with a pair of shafts and can be hand-drawn with a 'T' handle, and fitted with a rear push handle
- 52 PLEASURE DRIVING VEHICLE built by Dartmoor Carriages to suit pony up to 15.1 hh single or pair; painted black with black upholstery, comes with shafts and a pole and the axles have extended fittings for competitions
- 53 EXERCISE VEHICLE to fit 14.2 to 15.2 hh
- 54 LONDON TROLLEY in need of restoration
- 55 DEFENDER PONY VEHICLE built by Barry Wheelwright circa 1997, to fit a standard Shetland pony; painted black with gold lining, cane panel release. In show condition, season ready
- 56 VICTORIA circa 1900, one of a number of carriages sold from the Swedish Royal Mews in the 1980's, to fit a pair of horses approx. 14.2 hh or single 15-16 hh. Excellent condition, ready to go to work, very strong with perch underneath, sound throughout, comes with pair of shafts
- 57 WAGONETTE painted red to fit a miniature Shetland pony
